Prof.Dr.-Ing. Jens Strackeljan holds a Ph.D. degree in Mechanical Eng. (Dr.-Ing.) from Technical University Clausthal, Germany. He is Rector of Otto-von-Guericke-University, Magdeburg, Germany, and President of the Association of the Rectors in Saxony-Anhalt. He started at Otto-von-Guericke-University in 2004 as a Professor for Technical Dynamics. Later he was Vice Dean Faculty of Mechanical Engineering and Vice Rector before starting as Rector in 2012. Earlier he worked at TU Clausthal as Postdoctoral Researcher and Researcher. He received his Diploma in Applied Mechanics, Mechanical Engineering, TU Clausthal.
